

## **NORWICH HOUSING SOCIETY – 30 YEAR ASPIRATION**

- **1.** To continue to serve the older population of the City of Norwich providing social rented housing for those 60 years and older.
- 2. Provide appropriate housing and tenancy support to enable our tenants to live well independently, signposting additional services as may be required.
- 3. To maintain our financial independence and viability whilst growing to approximately 400 homes.
- 4. Maintain and improve our housing stock to ensure that they remain fit for purpose for at least the following 30 years.
- 5. To improve our housing stock to ensure climate resilience for the foreseeable future.
- 6. To improve our housing stock to provide Lifetime Homes, or its equivalent, standard.
- 7. To ensure our service offer remains responsive, approachable and tenant focussed and that we maintain industry leading tenant satisfaction.
- 8. Invest in our employees to continually improve their competence, skills and motivation, ensuring we remain an employer of choice, to retain them and attract high quality staff.
- 9. Involve tenants in the operation and running of the Society both at scheme and organisational level.
- 10. To raise the Society's profile within Norwich ensuring we reach all substantive communities within the City of Norwich and its suburbs.
- 11. To support Stuart Court Memorial Charity almshouses to ensure they have a viable and worthwhile future.
